Her patent cases span a broad spectrum of technologies with a particular focus on Hatch-Waxman ANDA litigation and the electrical field. She has obtained significant victories in claim constructions, summary judgment, pre-trial, and discovery motions for her clients.

In addition, Padmaja has counseled clients on product launches, negotiated multi-million dollar license deals and prepared opinions of counsel. She is also experienced in procurement of patents and trademarks from the U.S. Patent Office. Her clients have ranged from multinational corporations to small start-ups and select individuals.
